Dennis Kanin is principal and co-founder of New Boston Ventures, a real estate development company in Boston. From 1985-2002, he was a partner at the law firm of Foley Hoag. Mr. Kanin has been actively involved in both government and politics over the past few decades. In 1991-92, he was National Campaign Manager for the presidential campaign of former U.S. Senator Paul E. Tsongas. From 1975-85, Mr. Kanin served as Tsongas' Chief of Staff in the U.S. Senate and U.S. House of Representatives. He was a member of both the National Democratic Party Commission on Platform Accountability (1982-84) and Charter Commission (1972-74). Mr. Kanin has also been active in community and civic organizations, serving as President of the Board of Trustees of The Roxbury Latin School, a Director of the Massachusetts Finance Agency and Chair of its Manufacturing and Defense Sectors Committee, New England Regional Chair and National Washington Affairs Chair of the Anti-Defamation League, Vice President of the Board of the Epiphany School, Co-Chair of Children's Hospital's Advocacy Campaign Advisory Group, and Advisory Board Member of the Massachusetts League of Environmental Voters.
